The Med.Pride project envisages the creation of a network of Centres of Excellence (CoE) from European and Mediterranean countries with the aim to implement an operational model for:


- 1. the creation of innovative enterprises;
- 2. the adoption of innovation in existing SMEs.

In order to successfully implement an innovation process, it is of the utmost importance to facilitate access to information on new technologies, improve services, enhance skills, competencies, know-how and avail of financial and other management tools.

In view of this Med. Pride targets its activities to improving the performances of organisations that could act as interfaces both for existing SMEs and for new enterprises.

Med.Pride will contribute in diffusing information technologies at two levels: at macro level, since a consistent part of the institutional CoE work will be carried out through the Internet; and at micro level, by adding value to the social and economic environments, through both the creation of innovative enterprises and by fostering the introduction of innovation in existing traditional sectors SMEs.





### Tools for development

To achieve the set goals this network will operate through a number of intervention tools:

- the realisation of a user friendly web-site, that can be enlarged and that can involve other countries and new potential partners;
- a shared Enterprise Creation model that is easily adapted to the specific needs of each single partner country;
- training, exchanging information and transferring technical know-how;
- the promotion of dissemination and visibility activities.

# Information technology brings goals closer

The realisation of this project envisages the creation of a dedicated web-site that permits the exchange of documents and information through a dedicated portal, together with the transference of know-how, through interactive satellite technologies.

This project envisages:

- the creation of Centres of Excellence and/or task force, dedicated to the implementation of specific actions that foster innovation and economic growth, through better use of ICT;

- an expert staff capable of competently tackling the creation of innovative enterprises;
- the creation of an international network to facilitate the exchange of experiences.
